1) Essay Writing Guidelines

The essay has a limit of 1000 words per entry. The essay has to be written in English. It should be submitted in word document or pdf. Please mention your full name on the top of the page of submission. Essay must be original and have not been published anywhere. Essay can provide references of sources cited.

- Prizes will be sent to the winners' given addresses.
